

## **Geometry Policies**

#### **Materials Needed**

The following supplies are needed for Geometry:

- Binder with loose-leaf Paper
- Pencils/Erasers
- Pens for correcting
- Calculator

Ink pens should NOT be used for any math assignments or tests. Your binder will be your tool to organize class materials. If you have a different way of organizing, feel free to do so. However, if you are missing materials for class, you will not be allowed to leave class to go to your locker.

#### **Skill Sheets**

A basic skill sheet will be due weekly. The sheet will be about 20 questions that review topics learned in previous courses or earlier in Geometry. Skill sheet packets will be distributed during the first week of school. One sheet will be due each week, usually on Friday.

#### **Homework Assignments/Late Work Policy**

The purpose of homework is to practice what you are learning. Homework will be due at the beginning of the class period. Unfinished homework still needs to be completed. Late homework will not be accepted for credit. If you are absent on the day an assignment is due, you are expected to turn it in on the day you return.

#### **Make-up Work**

If you miss class for any reason, it is your responsibility to get caught up. A note will be placed in the make-up work folder for you to see what you missed. You have two days for every missed day to turn in make-up work. It is the student's responsibility to turn in any make-up work.

#### **Warm Ups/Beginning of Class Routine**

A short warm up will be given daily. This will be posted as you enter. When you enter math class, you should pick up your assigned laptop and your assigned calculator, if needed. As you get seated, check that you have all your materials with you. If necessary, sharpen your pencil and pick up any make-up work. Then set out your homework to be checked and begin working on the warm up problems.

### **Quizzes, Tests, and Projects**

A quiz or test will be given about every week. One day's notice will usually be given. No more than one class period will be allowed to complete it. Projects will be assigned for most chapters. Projects are weighted the same as tests in your overall grade.

### **Grading**

Grades will be weighted according to the following percentages:

- 50% Tests and Projects
- 40% Quizzes
- 10% Skill Sheets and Other
